## Bank Robbery Arrest



July 26, 2022 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On July 22nd, 2022, officers with the Pueblo Police Department were able to successfully identify the bank robbery suspect involved in the bank robbery that occurred on Thursday, July 21, 2022, at US Bank (1130 Bonforte Blvd) as 23-year-old, Kaylie Dora. Dora also had an active warrant for her arrest for a previous bank robbery that occurred back in March of 2022 for a bank robbery at US Bank (3330 N. Elizabeth Ave).

July 22nd, 2022, officers were sent to Vectra Bank (4040 W. Northern Ave.) on a suspicious female who matched the description of Kaylie Dora. The female was able to leave the area before officers arrived on scene but was seen leaving the area as a passenger in a stolen vehicle.

On July 23rd, 2022, officers located Kaylie Dora, while she was sitting in a vehicle near the intersection of W. Northern Ave. and Pine Street. Kaylie was arrested for the two active warrants for bank robbery.

Dora has been previously listed as an FBI Safe Streets Wanted Criminal.

The information contained in this press release is based on preliminary information available at the time of its drafting.
