

## Shooting Investigation

On August 28, 2022, at approximately 11:18 p.m., Pueblo Police were dispatched to 4000 block of N. Elizabeth St. on a report of a shooting. Police found a wounded security guard that had been shot. Police rendered medical aid to the security guard until an ambulance arrived.

The suspect is described as Hispanic male, wearing a blue or purple hat, black t-shirt with either gold or white writing across the front, grey jeans and black shoes. The suspect was last seen running westbound on Patty Ln.

The suspect was contacted by the security guard for being a suspicious person on the property. The security guard did not sustain serious bodily injury from the gunshot wound and is in stable condition.
