## Burglary Arrest

The suspect was observed inside the building and leaving the building. Police contacted 34-year-old, Orlando Mendoza Chavez-Venegas, walking with a green Kawasaki KX85 in the 4100 block of Club Manor Drive. Chavez-Venegas denied being in the business.

Chavez-Venegas was booked into the Pueblo County Judicial Building for the crime(s) of 2nd Degree Burglary, 2nd Degree Motor Vehicle Theft, and Criminal Mischief.
