City of Pueblo Police Department Weekly Safe Streets Wanted Criminal Round-Up

The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Angelo Naranjo (19) is described as a Hispanic male, 5'00", 90 pounds, black hair with brown eyes. Naranjo has a warrant for Homicide – Murder 1 – After Deliberation – Attempted. He has a second warrant for Carrying a Concealed Weapon which includes Driver's License – Driving Without and License Plates – Unlawful Display. His total bond amount is \$252,500.

Michael Bundy (19) is described as a White male, 5'10", 170 pounds, with brown hair and blue eyes. Bundy has three warrants. He has a no bond warrant for Traffic Offense – Motor Vehicle Theft, Careless Driving, Vehicular Eluding, Leaving the Scene of an Accident – Damage Only. His second warrant is for Contempt of Court which includes Weapon Offense - Weapon Possession Previous Juvenile Offender – Any Prior Felony. His third warrant is for Failure to Comply which includes Trespass 1 – Auto with Intent Commit Crime – Attempted. His total bond amount is \$8,500.
