## Burglary Arrests



September 14, 2022



On September 12, 2022, Pueblo Police officers responded to the 1100 block of Lake Ave. on an attempt to locate Safe Streets fugitive 40-year-old, Raymond Smith. Smith had 6 active warrants for his arrest. Smith attempted to run on foot, but he was caught after a short foot chase. Police determined that Smith and 38-year-old, Noah Wimber were involved in several storage unit burglaries.

Police recovered several truckloads of stolen property. Police were able to contact several victims from the storage units and are in the process of getting all the stolen items returned to the rightful owners. This investigation continues and additional charges are expected. Smith was arrested on new charges of 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Burglary x5, his warrants were for Contempt of Court x4, Fugitive of Justice x2. Wimber was arrested on 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary x5, and Complicity.
