





Weekly Safe Streets Wanted Criminal Round-Up

The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Anastasia Chancellor (20) is described as a White female, 5'08", 150 pounds, with blonde hair and brown eyes. Chancellor has three warrants. She has a warrant for Forgery which includes Forgery Check/Commercial Instrument, Criminal Impersonation–Gain a Benefit and Defrauding–Secured Credit. She has two warrants, one being no bond, for Failure to Comply which includes Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Criminal Impersonation–Gain a Benefit and False Reporting–False Identification. Her total bond amount is \$20,200.

Timothy Pate (42) is described as a White male, 6'00", 155 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. Pate has four warrants. He has two no bond warrants for Contempt of Court which includes: Violation of a Protection Order x2, Harassment, Burglary and Trespass. His third warrant is for Flight Escape–Flight to Avoid which includes Unauthorized Absence–Aggravated-Victim Rights Act/Crime of Violence. His fourth warrant is for Failure to Appear which includes Contempt of Court and Violation of a Protection Order. His total bond is \$15,000.
