





October 12, 2022 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On October 11, 2022, at approximately 11:30 p.m., Officers with the Pueblo Police Department were sent to a residence in the 2300 block of W. 13th Street on the report of shots fired.

Upon arrival, officers located a deceased adult male on scene. Patrol officers contacted witnesses inside the residence and Crimes Against Persons Detectives were called out to take over the investigation. A suspect has not been identified, no arrests have been made and the relationship between the deceased and the suspect is unknown. Based on preliminary information this does appear to be an isolated incident with no further threat to the community.

The identity of the deceased male will later be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office once all appropriate notifications are made.
