Suspicious Death

On October 12, 2022, at approximately 11:55 a.m., officers with the Pueblo Police Department were notified that the body of a deceased male had been found near the 100 block of N. Dayton Ave.

Due to the unknown circumstances surrounding the death, the Crimes Against Persons Detectives were called to process this incident as a suspicious death. ID Detectives are continuing to process the scene and collect evidence.

Based on initial information, this does appear to be an isolated incident with no further threat to the community.

The identity of the deceased male will later be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office once all appropriate notifications are made.
