City of Pueblo Police Department Arrests Made in Drive-By Shootings

On October 13th and October 14th, 2022, patrol officers were dispatched to several drive-by shootings that included the areas of the 1600 block of Spruce St. and 2000 block of E. Orman Ave.

On October 14th patrol officers and detectives gathered information regarding a suspect vehicle from one of these drive-by shootings. This information led to an extensive investigation in the 3000 block of Baltimore Ave., where they located the suspect vehicle owned by Bobbi Sue Aguilar.

A search warrant was authored and executed for the residence on Baltimore Ave. where several handguns were recovered.

Occupants of the residence, Bobbi Sue Aguilar (33), Zacariah Trujillo-Martinez (19) and Jacob Archuleta (19) were taken into custody. Officers have taken several recent reports involving these three individuals.

Zacariah Trujillo-Martinez and Jacob Archuleta were arrested on eight counts of Criminal Attempt to Commit 1st Degree Murder. Bobbi Sue Aguilar was arrested on eight counts of Complicity to Criminal Attempt to Commit 1st Degree Murder as the driver of the vehicle during these drive-by shootings.

Additional charges are pending for all three individuals upon completion of further investigation.
