Stabbing

October 17, 2022 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]

On Saturday, October 15, 2022, at approximately 6:50 p.m., officers were dispatched to 4171 N. Elizabeth St. (KFC) in reference to a stabbing. As officers responded, they were notified of a traffic accident that happened at HWY 50 and N. Elizabeth.

When officers arrived at the accident, they were informed a male who was inside one of the vehicles involved in the accident had been stabbed at the KFC. The victim walked away from the accident scene but was quickly located walking eastbound on HWY 50. He was transported to a local hospital to be treated for his injuries. The victim was in serious but stable condition.

The male suspect left KFC before officers arrived. The suspect later called Pueblo Police Dispatch to inform officers of his location. Officers responded to the male's location and transported him for questioning.

Detectives with the Crimes Against Persons Unit were called out to continue the investigation. No arrests have been made at this time. This is an active, ongoing investigation. This is an isolated incident with no threat to the community.
