Arrest made in Multiple Burglaries

October 24, 2022



On Wednesday, October 20th, 2022, at approximately 12:00am, Pueblo Police Officers were dispatched to a local business on the 2100 block of Jerry Murphy Rd, regarding a possible burglary in progress.

Dispatch received a call from the restaurant's surveillance video technician who reported receiving an alert someone was on the property and was watching live footage. The technician reported seeing a male kneeling near the restaurant's patio gate and using an electric saw in attempt to force entry into the patio. The caller stated the male was wearing a dark colored hoodie and dark colored pants.

Officers in the area contacted a male matching the description given by the surveillance technician. The male suspect was identified as Michael Trujillo. Michael was still in possession of the electric saw suspected to be used to cause the damage at the business.

Michael was transported to the Pueblo County Judicial Center and booked in on charges of 2nd Degree Burglary, Criminal Mischief, and Possession of Burglary Tools. Michael was booked into the Pueblo County Judicial Center at 1:24am. He was released the same day at 7:55pm on a \$5,000 PR (personal recognizance) bond.

On Saturday, October 22nd, 2022, at approximately 1:00am, Pueblo Police Officers were dispatched to a local business on the 2000 block of Hudson Ave. on a report of a burglary in progress.

Upon arrival, officers observed a boarded-up window that had been opened. As officers approached the window, a male suspect exited the broken window carrying merchandise from the store. The suspect attempted to run from officers, but he was quickly taken into custody.

The suspect was later identified as Michael Trujillo. This is the same male that was arrested two days prior for committing the same offenses at the business located on Jerry Murphy Rd. He was, again, booked into the Pueblo County Judicial Center on charges of 2nd Degree Burglary and Criminal Mischief.

At the time of this news release, Michael remains in custody.
