Aggravated Robbery Arrest

On Monday, October 24, 2022, at approximately 7:35pm, officers were dispatched to a business on the 1500 block of W. 4th St. in reference to an armed robbery.

Upon arrival, officers learned the male suspect was aggressively panhandling from customers near the entrance of the business. An employee asked the male to leave the area, but the male returned inside. Once inside, the male approached the counter and insinuated he had a weapon in his waistband. He then demanded money from the clerk. The male took the cash drawer and ran out of the store and continued running east, on W. 4th St. Officers located the cash drawer in the area.

Moments later, dispatch received a call for another armed robbery at a business on the 600 block of N. Grand Ave.

The description of this robbery suspect matched the same description given for the robbery that occurred on the 1500 block of W. 4th St. The suspect pulled open the cash drawer, took the money within, then left the area.

Officers received information the suspect was in the area of W 8th St. & Grand Ave. headed north bound. Officers contacted the suspect in the 1000 block of N. Main St. The suspect was later identified as 36 year old, Rapheon Bynum.

Rapheon was booked into the Pueblo County Judicial Center on aggravated robbery.
