Aggravated Robbery Arrest

October 31, 2022



On Thursday, October 27, 2022, at approximately 4:35pm, officers were dispatched to a business on the 1200 block of US HWY 50, regarding a strong-armed robbery.

Staff stated a male walked into the bank and approached a teller station. The male instructed the teller to give him all the money. The male was given the money and he left the building.

Officers spoke to witnesses on scene who were able to give a detailed description of the suspect, to include his clothing. Part of the clothing description was black jacket with white writing on the front, white stripes on the collar, bottom of the sleeves, and waist of the jacket.

On Friday, October 28, 2022, at approximately 12:46pm, Officers contacted a male with a stolen handgun at a business on the 600 block W. US HWY 50. The male was later identified as 30-year-old, Josiah Scott. Officers noticed his distinct jacket, which was black with white lettering on the front, white stripes around the collar, bottom of the sleeves as well as the waist of the jacket which matched the description of the bank robbery suspect from the day prior.

A witness from the bank robbery was able to positively identify Josiah.

After further investigation, it was found Josiah also robbed another business on Wednesday, October 19, 2022. An arrest warrant was authored for him from that incident, but the warrant was not yet active.

Josiah was transported to the Pueblo County Judicial Center and booked in on charges of aggravated robbery and theft.
