## Homicide



November 6, 2022



On Sunday, November 6, 2022, at approximately 1:10am, Pueblo Police Officers were dispatched to the 3200 block of Nuckolls Ave. in Pueblo, Colorado, on a report of a drive by shooting.

Once officers arrived on scene, they located a white sedan that had crashed into a tree on the west end of the block. As they approached the vehicle, they contacted a female passenger. She was transported to a local hospital to be treated for her injuries. Officers also located a male driver who was found to be deceased upon officer arrival.

This incident is currently being investigated as a homicide.

Crimes Against Persons Detectives were called to investigate this incident. ID Detectives were called out to process the scene and collect evidence.

Based on initial information, this does appear to be an isolated incident with no further threat to the community. No arrests have been made at this time. This is still an active and ongoing investigation.

The identity of the deceased will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office. This is the 23rd homicide investigation in 2022.
