Attempted Murder Arrest

On Saturday, November 5, 2022, at approximately 12:41am, Pueblo Police Dispatch received a call from a business in the 900 block of W. Northern Ave. reporting there were multiple shots fired in the parking lot and the parties had left.

At approximately 12:43am, dispatch received another call from a female who stated she had been shot and was actively driving herself to a local hospital.

At approximately 12:49am, an officer was on a separate call for service at a local hospital and aired a male with a gunshot wound had walked into the hospital for treatment.

Preliminary information revealed two males approached a vehicle parked in front of the business and opened fire, injuring the parties inside the vehicle.

Detectives from the Special Investigation Division were called out to assist with this incident. During their investigation and review of surveillance video, they were able to identify the suspects and the suspect vehicle. Their diligence led to the arrest of 18-year-old, Jaquin Avila.

Jaquin was transported to the Pueblo County Judicial Center and booked in on two charges of Criminal Attempt to Commit First Degree Murder.

This is still an active and ongoing investigation and additional arrests are expected.
