REQUEST: A Special Use Permit to allow a residence, two-family, duplex, in a R-2 Single Family Residential Zone District

DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST

The applicant is requesting a Special Use Permit for a residence, two-family, duplex, in a R-2 Single Family Zone District for the purposes of constructing a new two family attached structure. The property is located in the southeastern portion of the Bessemer neighborhood. The existing, long term vacant, small home currently on the property will be removed and a new, 32' x 76' (2,432) manufactured duplex will be installed. Section 17-2-2 (128)(g)) of the Municipal Code dictates that a residence two-family, duplex, is a use by review in a single family residential zone district.

ANALYSIS

The existing property contains a small, 800 sq. ft. adobe, alley house the was erected in the early 1900s. The property is severely deteriorated, and the prior owner was cited by code enforcement for trash and liter in 2023. Despite its small size, records indicate the property was used as a duplex in the 1950s and the address has a water tap for two units documenting it was a duplex at one time.

The applicant plans to install a new two unit manufactured home. The new structure will be front facing, both units having street facing front entryways covered by an overhang. Architecturally the building will have vinyl siding, recessed front porch, small side gable for rear/side door, and shutters on all the windows. The proposed design will meet the minimum eight architectural elements for a new single family residential unit. Furthermore, the unit will have a 20-foot front yard setback, which is the average setback established by the adjacent homes to the north and south (Section 17-4-31, (5) of the Pueblo Municipal Code) creating a 15-foot rear-yard setback for four paved tenant parking spaces. The owner may add a small deck off of the rear for tenants in the future. The property will have nine-foot setbacks on each side yard and staff is requiring a six-foot cedar fence on both sides to provide some additional setbacks and screening/privacy for adjacent properties.

Due to its location close to the old main gate for the steel mill, this section of Bessemer hosts many multifamily units and accessory dwelling units. The property to the north 1901/1901 1/2 E. Routt has an accessory dwelling

unit (ADU) adjacent to the alley. The proposed duplex use is a use by right across the street, to the east which is zoned R-3. The Bessemer neighborhood contains duplexes and triplexes as well as ADUs and the proposed use is in keeping with the prevailing and historic land use pattern of the neighborhood. Finally, the new use will remove a blighted vacant structure and provide additional housing units within the neighborhood.

The property was publicly noticed in accordance with Title 17 Section 17-5-33(2) of the City of Pueblo Municipal Code. Specifically, the hearing was published in the Pueblo Chieftain, surrounding property owners within 100 feet of the property were notified by mail, and a sign was placed on the site (See Attachment E). These notices occurred at least 10 days prior to the hearing.

CONDITIONS REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL USE PERMIT

1. Ingress and egress to property and proposed structures thereon with reference to automotive and pedestrian safety and convenience, traffic flow and control, and access in case of fire or catastrophe.

Comments: Affirmative, there is one deteriorated drive cut from the street but the applicant’s site plan shows him providing access and parking at the rear along the alley outside the front and rear setbacks.

2. Off-street parking and loading areas where required, with particular attention to the economic noise, glare, or odor effects of the use by review on adjoining properties and properties generally in the district.

Comments: Affirmative, sufficient off-street parking and loading will be provided along the alley. The property requires two parking spaces and will provide four. Currently, the house has been vacant for many years creating blight and fire danger for surrounding neighbors. A new building will erase those existing risks and reduce trash dumping which the property was cited for in 2023.

3. Refuse and service areas, with reference to the items above.

Comments: Affirmative, the applicant states they will comply with the requirements under the City Code.

4. Utilities, with reference to the location's availability and compatibility.

Comments: Affirmative finding. Utilities serving the existing uses are anticipated to be sufficient to serve the needs of the proposed use. User intends to comply with any building code required revisions to utilities serving the structure/use.

5. Screening and buffering with reference to type, dimensions, and character.

Comments: The proposed home must meet the single-family home placements standards and proposes nine foot setbacks on the sideways, Staff recommends a cedar fence on both side property lines as well.

6. Signs, if any, and proposed exterior lighting with reference to glare, traffic, safety, economic effect and compatibility and harmony with properties in the district.

Comments: Affirmative finding. No signage and no outdoor lighting other than porch lights have been proposed.

7. Required yards and other open space.

Comments: Affirmative finding. The current property provides adequate open space to meet the requirements of the City Code. Any future infill development will utilize existing pavement and hardscape associated with the existing infrastructure to the extent feasible, retaining any existing landscape areas.

8. General compatibility with adjacent properties and other properties in the district.

Comments: Affirmative finding. The adjacent property has an accessory dwelling unit along the alley and across the street the zoning is R-3. Other duplexes exist in the area and a six plex is located less than a block away. The proposed home is more compatible than the alley home that is now a fire hazard.

PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT STAFF RECOMMENDATION

If the Board chooses to approve this Special Use Permit staff recommends Standard Permit Conditions 1 through 13 and the following staff recommended conditions

1. The applicant must meet the eight minimum single family home placement standards.
2. The applicant provide a cedar wood fence on the northern and property line fence with adjacent neighbors.

Exhibit A. Standard Permit Conditions

Standard Permit Conditions Date of Issuance of Permit: 4/23/2024	
1.	Time Limits Zoning permit shall become invalid unless work or action authorized by permit is fully executed by 4/23/2025
2.	Required Revisions Any revisions or additions to plans required as a result of approval must be submitted and stamped “approved” prior to the sign-off of the building permit routing slip or business license.
3.	Changes The project shall be completed as shown on the plans, which have been stamped “approved” and dated by the Department of Planning and Community Development. The project shall not deviate from the approved plans without prior written approval from the Department of Planning and Community Development.
4.	Property Inspection By acceptance of this permit, Permit holder authorizes City Officials and/or their authorized representatives, access to the subject property for purpose of observing work in progress, inspecting and/or measuring the property or improvements as long as the use authorized by this permit remains in effect.
5.	Certificate of Occupancy A certificate of occupancy must be issued by Regional Building <u>PRIOR</u> to use and/or occupancy of the subject premises. Prior to issuance, the Department of Planning and Community Development must certify that work has been completed in accordance with approved plans and that applicable conditions have been met. The Permit holder may be required to provide a Letter of Credit to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy prior to completion of all required improvements.
6.	Completion and Maintenance of Improvements and Landscaping Permit holder or successor in interest is responsible for completing all improvements shown on approved plans. By acceptance of this permit, Permit holder agrees to maintain all improvements in a satisfactory condition. Any landscaping installed according to the approved plan which becomes diseased, or dies shall be replaced by similar species and size no later than the first available planting season.
7.	Building Permit; Other Permits Permit holder is solely responsible for obtaining <u>BUILDING PERMIT</u> and all other applicable local, state, and federal permits.
8.	Off-Site Drainage Issuance of this permit does not authorize the discharge of stormwater runoff or other surface drainage from the subject premises onto adjoining property or properties.
9.	Appeals of a decision of the Land Use Administrator can occur up to thirty (30) days following such decision. Appeals of Zoning Board of Appeals decisions can occur up to thirty (30) days following final decision. Any work done in connection with this permit prior to the expiration of all applicable appeal periods is done <u>SOLELY</u> at the risk of the Permit holder.
10.	Errors Permit holder is solely responsible for the accuracy of all information contained in the Zoning Permit form and in accompanying documentation. Any errors contained therein may invalidate the Zoning Permit and may result in issuance of a code violation citation and prosecution.
11.	Transfer of Ownership In the event of a transfer of ownership, partial or whole, of the subject premises, the transferee shall become Permit holder and subject to compliance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
12.	Violations/Penalties A violation of any of the conditions of this permit or of any provision of the Pueblo Municipal Code may result in a penalty of up to three hundred dollars (\$300) per day.
13.	Incorporation and Reference of All Plans Presented to the Zoning Board of Appeals. This approval incorporates by reference all plans and drawings presented and all verbal representations by the applicant at Zoning Board of Appeals meetings and hearings on the subject application to the extent that they are not in conflict with other stated conditions or regulations.






