

ARE YOU REPRESENTED ON CITY BOARDS & COMMISSIONS?




Boards Survey **Census Population**


These are approximations as the survey ranges didn't exactly match census ranges.




RACE & ETHNICITY




EDUCATION



GENDER




PEOPLE WHO IDENTIFY AS HAVING A DISABILITY
