WHERE DO FATS, OIL AND GREASE COME FROM?

- Meats
- Butter and margarine
- Food scraps
- Sauces
- Dairy products



DON'T GET CLOGGED.

- Never pour fats, oil, grease or food scraps into your sink, garbage disposal or toilet. Pour into a can and place in the trash.
- Scrape or wipe grease and food from pans and plates into the trash



WHAT CAN HAPPEN?

Fats, oils, grease and food scraps don't mix well with water. When flushed, these materials can build up and block the entire sewer pipeline and cause raw sewage overflows into your home, lawns, streets, parks and rivers...

- Creating health risks

- Costing you money

PREVENTION

- Keep your service line free from fats, oil and grease.
- Keep your service line free from tree roots.
- Install a ball cock valve to keep wastewater from backing into your home
